**Proposed Extraction of Sand and Gravel from Land off Norwich Road (B1332),  
Ditchingham.(NCC Ref: C/7/2005/7019)**

Thank you for your latest letter dated 3 November enclosing copy correspondence to Mr J Gough at David L Walker; your comments are duly noted.

As you are aware a full planning application and accompanying Environmental Statement have been submitted to the County Council and now this has been formally registered, copies will be circulated to all the Statutory Consultees shortly. At the discretion of Lafarge, additional copies of the Environmental Statement will be sent free of charge both to Mr & Mrs Chadd and yourself.

The legislation requires that a Non Technical Summary for applications involving Environmental Statements is produced – to provide a summary which is non technical. The full Environmental Statement produced by independent technical experts in their own specialist fields, uses appropriate terminology for consideration by similar specialists.

It is, of course, the right of any individual or organisation to submit a planning application for development. The determining authority will judge the acceptability or otherwise of any application in the context of the Development Plan and other relevant material considerations. It is also the democratic right of yourself and any other interested parties to make formal representation to the determining authority now the application has been formally registered.

It is perhaps inevitable that developers and local communities do from time to time have different opinions on development proposals. As our application has now been submitted to the planning authority for consideration, we see no further benefit in continuing this correspondence and I have instructed David L Walker Chartered Surveyors accordingly. I suggest that all future questions and opinions are addressed directly to Norfolk County Council who can raise relevant issues with us as appropriate.
