With regard to surrendering Options, this would apply only to the 2001 Option and would surely not prevent any later agreements.

Concerning Landfilling the least expected would be a legally binding undertaking that Lafage and the Estate would not undertake, or permit others to do so.

Concerning deliveries in the form of readymix this is a concern of many.

Any right of way would be little compensation for the effect of this application, should it be successful.

So as you can see the general concern, as expressed at the 12<sup>th</sup> December meeting, is still very great and your letter has only served to warrant further information.
